- 36 candidates reviewed; 18 forwarded for nominations
- 10 World Board seats, 3 HRP seats, 1 Co-Facilitator position
- World Board required 60% support
- HRP & Co-Facilitators required >50% support
- Focus on service experience and collaborative leadership

More opportunities for broad discussion of new ideas



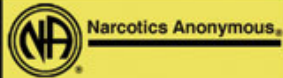

- Additional concerns: AI, illicit literature, low survey participation

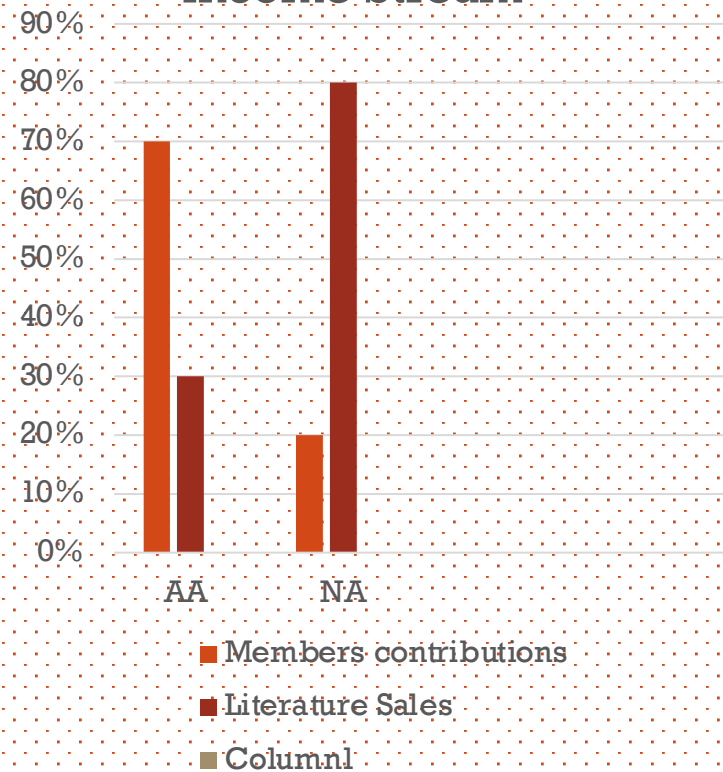


FINANCIAL OVERVIEW



- 80% of income from literature sales
- 20% from fellowship contributions
- FY2029 projected deficit
- Literature net income: approx. \$19.3 million
- Fellowship contributions: approx. \$6.1 million
- Operational costs covered for a year could lead to potential lower Basic Text cost.

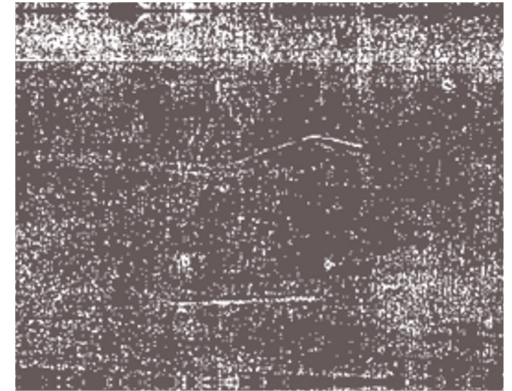
MAJOR CONFERENCE DISCUSSIONS

- CAR Survey process to continue with improvements
- Discussion on gender-neutral language in literature- Begin work on IP 1 for review
- Tradition 11 and social media discussions. How can we address the current policy?
